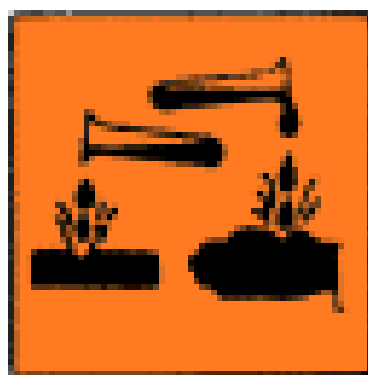

## Transport of Dangerous Goods

There are a defined set of regulations that are concerned with the Transport of Dangerous goods by Road, Rail, Sea and Air. We are mainly concerned with Road transport . These regulations cover the loading, transport and unloading of dangerous substances.

### Background

Two cases are presented here that cover DGSA activities for differing organisations that are involved in the transport of Dangerous Goods.

### Case Study

A company that we deal with supplies dangerous goods to the airline industry in the UK and abroad. Journeys are either road or multi-modal (road and air) and they use 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Hauliers for transporting their goods.
